#### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Leon "Lee" Kramer, originally from Cairo, Egypt, founded High Fidelity SSS in Atlanta, Georgia. It was the first store in the Southeast specializing in home audio-video. His wife, Charlotte Baker Kramer, ran the Atlanta Zen Center for 30 years. Charlotte was the daughter of Fred Baker, a World War I veteran and employee of the Works Progress Administration. Lee and Charlotte Kramer had two children, Lorr and Mya Kramer.
